Build conceptual understanding of participants on gender, feminism and movement building and their link to human rights. Develop strategic skills by looking at and analyzing some social movements and successful advocacy campaigns in South Asia. Build communication skills that will enable participants to prepare effective written communication material, social messaging in videos and documentaries and use ICTs for human rights work.

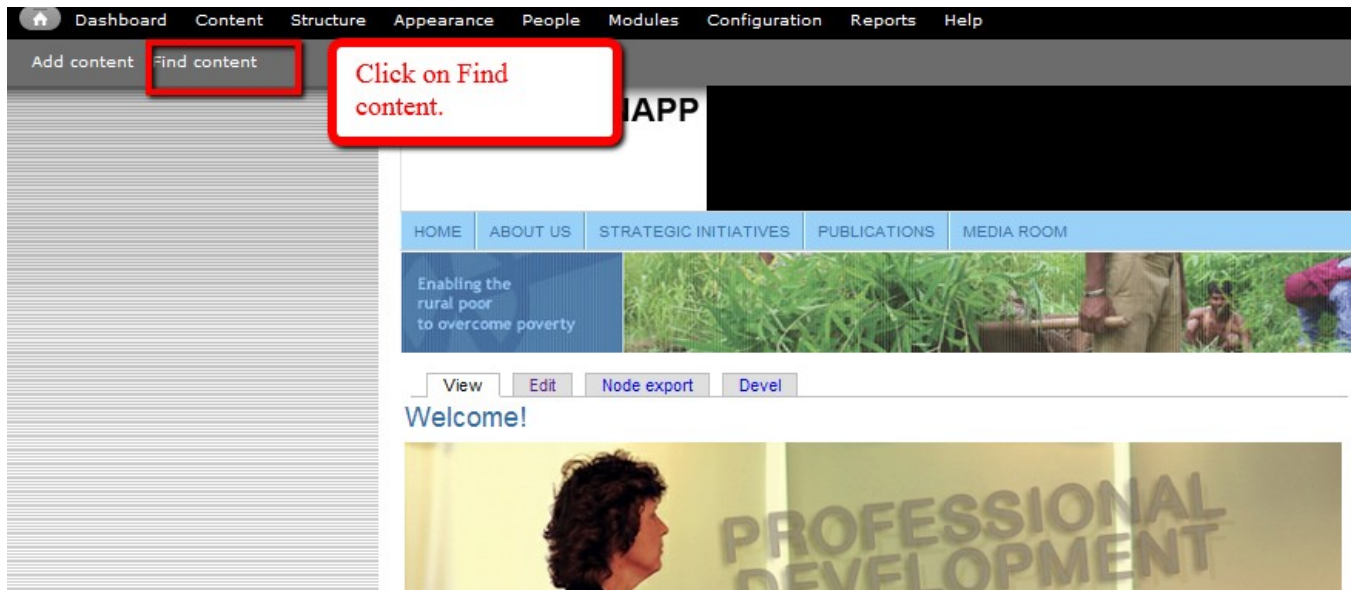
